Lymm Dam Circular Walk – Wheelchair Friendly

A walk suitable for push chairs, wheelchairs and the less surefooted.

There are no steps but the path slopes upwards and downwards in places. It can be muddy after wet weather.

About 1 mile (2km)

Park at St Mary's Church Hall car park on Crouchley Lane (WA13 0AS).

Head towards Lymm Dam and you will see a well-defined path, sign posted Crosfield Bridge. After about 100 metres, take the right hand fork. The path loops out towards the dam. Follow the path as it loops back towards the dam again with a good viewpoint. As this path meets the original path, keep left now on the original path and follow it to Crosfield Bridge.

Cross over the bridge and take the path on the right. Follow this path through the woodland until you reach the main road at the end of the dam. There are a couple of steeper sections on this path; an alternative route is to follow Lakeside Road.

Turn right here and walk up past the church and the Church Green pub, turning right into Crouchley Lane. The car park is here on the right.
