

Lymm Village and The Bridgewater Canal Walk from the Ranger Cabin

A circular route of about 2 ¼ miles (3.6 km), along the Trans Pennine Trail, the Bridgewater canal into Lymm Village. The route follows footpaths, the canal towpath and minor roads. There are some steps and the path can be muddy in places in the winter.

From the Ranger Cabin (WA13 9NJ), head west along the Trans Pennine Trail (you will be heading west if you keep the Ranger Cabin on your right).


Go over the next road crossing (Star Lane) and continue along the Trans Pennine Trail until you reach a footbridge over the trail. Pass under the bridge and you will see some steps leading up to it on your right.

Climb the steps, cross the bridge then follow the path along and round to the left in front of the cottages then right up to the Bridgewater Canal.

Turn left onto the Bridgewater Canal towpath and walk into the village centre. Leave the towpath at the bridge by the Golden Fleece (this will be the second overbridge you come to). If you would like to spend some time in the village centre, cross the bridge or to continue with the walk, head down the Danebank Road (with the small speed bumps)

Continue over the crossroads at the bottom and walk along Lymmhay Lane. Cross the Trans Pennine Trail and past the “Life for a Life” memorial forest. Shortly afterwards, you’ll see a footpath on the left, leading over a bridge and into the golf course. Keep straight on this path, across a fairway and to the entrance drive to the golf club. Turn left up the drive to meet Whitbarrow Road to the Trans Pennine Trail crossing and turn right, back to the cabin.
