

## Two Wishes – Lymm Dam Figure of Eight Walk

There are some steps and narrow paths, and it can be muddy after rain.

About 1.5 miles (2.6km)

Park at St Mary's Church Hall car park on Crouchley Lane (WA13 0AS).

Head towards Lymm Dam and you will see a well-defined path, sign posted Crosfield Bridge. Take this path and at the fork in about 100 meters, take the right hand path. Follow this path round along the edge of the meadows with views over the dam.

Where two paths converge, follow the right hand path down some steps as it loops through the woods and past some steep banks on your left. You come to a bridge over the slipway and then the Wishing Bridge, over a small waterfall. Follow the path, and look for a set of steps on the left. Go up the steps and follow this path to Crosfield Bridge.

Cross over the bridge and follow the path straight ahead until you see some steps on the left, leading down to the two bridges you crossed earlier. Cross the bridges again, making a second wish, and this time follow the path to the right. At the wooden walkway, take the steps down to the path that runs alongside the dam.

Follow this path until you reach the main road. Turn right here and walk along the end of the dam, and then turn right through a gate in the white railings. After a while, take a path on the left climbing a flight of steps up towards the Church. At the fork, take the left hand path and you'll get back to the car park.
