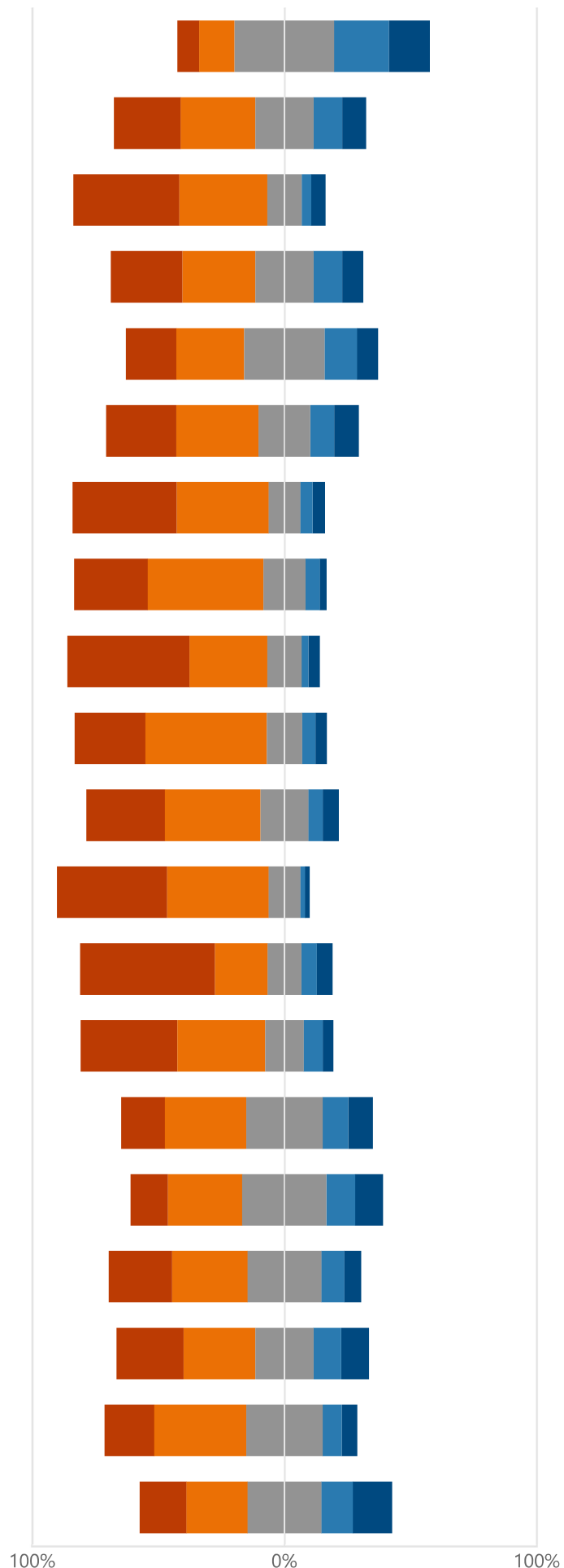

## 2. Council Tax / Parish Precept:

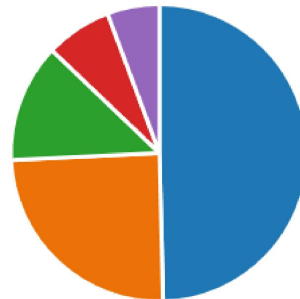

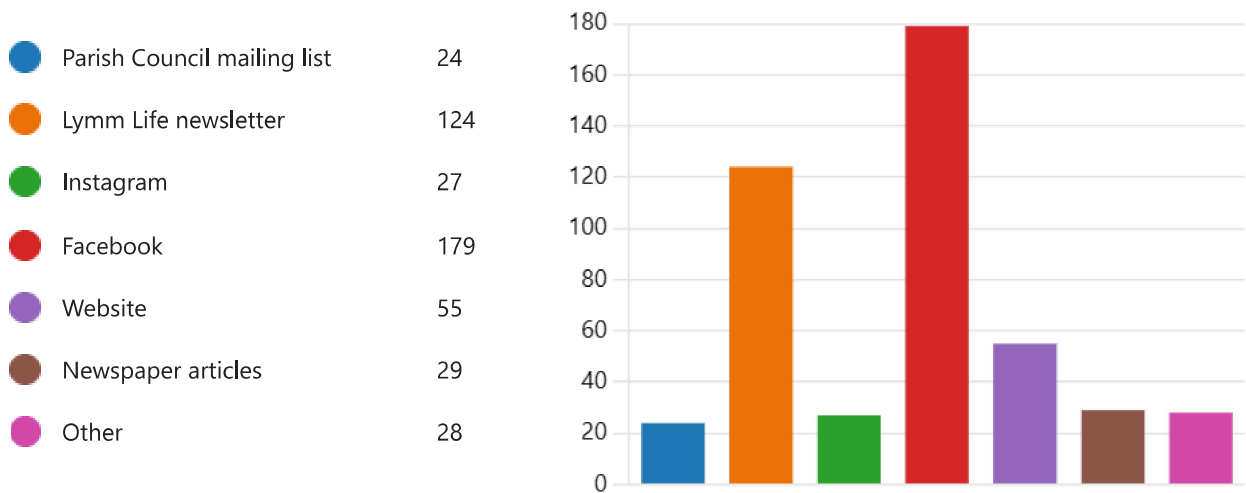

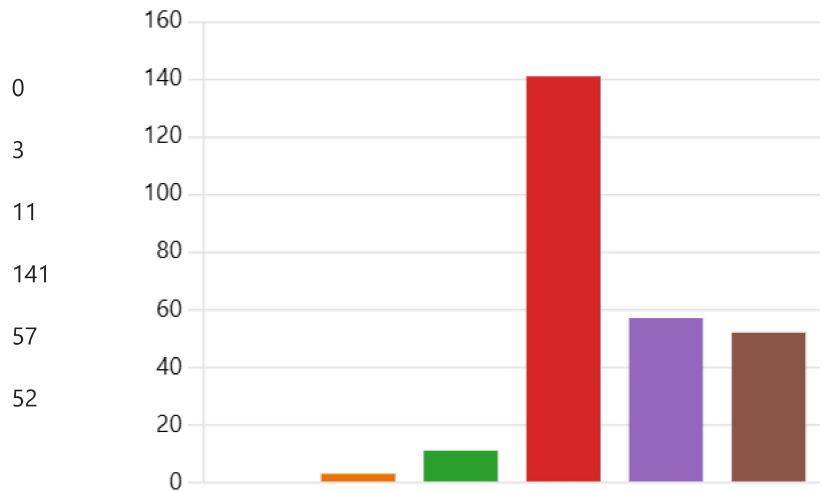
